

REQUEST FOR NON-TRADITIONAL SUPERVISION

A counselor may petition to the Board for use of non-traditional supervision. Guidelines are as follows:

- a. The counselor must be able to demonstrate a hardship that would justify the need for non-traditional supervision.
- b. Non-traditional supervision pre-approval will come through a Plan of Supervision.
- c. A minimum of 20 of the 60 required individual hours be done face to face. The 20 hours of traditional face to face meetings would include the initial meeting between the counselor and the supervisor and the hours necessary to establish a counselor/supervisor relationship.
- d. The counselor and supervisor must assure strict and secure precautions to ensure the utmost confidentiality.
- e. Petitions for non-traditional supervision approval will be reviewed on a case by case basis.
